Project Experience

QUAYSIDE QUARTER



CLIENT: Galliard Homes Limited **LOCATION:** London Borough of Ealing

Project Detail: We developed a comprehensive Waste Management Strategy for an ambitious development to include 2000 residential units across 7 blocks, 23,000sqm of creative industrial space (film studios), light industrial and mixed commercial uses. With challenges around limited ground floor space a negotiated solution was agreed with the local authority for an increased frequency of collection of waste streams to ensure the limited space would be able to manage the disposal needs of the end users.

`Galliard Homes have worked closely with Stantec, on numerous schemes across the Capital. They have led on waste management discussions with the relative Local Authorities ensuring an appropriate balance of waste storage and collections provides for the most efficient design response. These pre-application engagements ensure early agreed strategies are clear and understood by all parties, for a betterment of the proposals. This is a beneficial discipline to any application, especially given the pressures lower floors of buildings are under to accommodate mixed uses, active frontages, lobbies, servicing, storage, etc.'

LONDON BOROUGH OF MERTON, URBAN REGENERATION

CLIENT: Clarion Housing **LOCATION:** London

Stantec has provided waste management advice to multiple sites of urban regeneration within the London Borough of Merton. The Waste Strategy covered both residential and commercial uses and introduced an underground refuse storage (URS) solution within the Borough. We were able to ensure that the capacity requirements were met, resulting in significant savings in ground floor space, that would otherwise have been required for refuse and recycling storage. This space can now instead be considered for additional valuable commercial or residential units. Stantec also supported on the Section 106 negotiations between the client and the authority.

LOCATION: North Devon

A Waste Management Strategy covering both construction and operational phases and an EIA chapter was provided for a residential led mix use scheme in North Devon. The development site offered specific challenges to overcome around the topography and the resultant concerns regarding cut and fill and material movement off site. Close consultation with the local authority and project team helped to ensure waste considerations were managed in line with client expectation.

OXFORDSHIRE GARDEN VILLAGE

LOCATION: West Oxfordshire

A comprehensive Waste Strategy was developed for a sustainable garden village in West Oxfordshire, which is set to deliver 2,200 new homes, green space, community amenities and a business park. With the key foundation of proposals being high levels of sustainability throughout, careful consideration of both the construction and the operational waste was paramount. The principles of the circular economy were embedded within the Strategy throughout also ensuring in practice, a workable and efficient waste system was developed.
